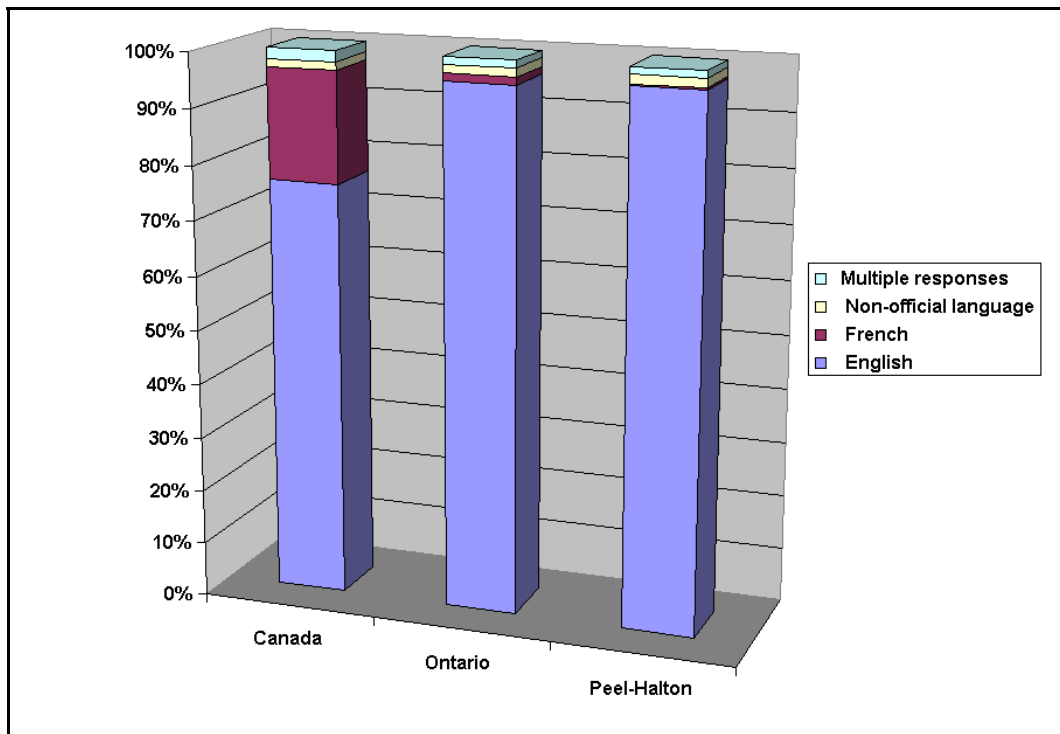
Language Used at Work

Did you know?

How many workers in Peel-Halton (PH) use English at work?

Compared to Canada and Ontario, PH had a higher proportions of workers who used English at work in 2006 [Canada (76.4%); Ontario (95.7%) versus PH (96.8%)]

How many workers in Peel-Halton (PH) use more than one language at work?

Compared to Canada, PH had a lower proportion of workers who used more than one language at work in 2006 [Canada (1.9%) versus PH (1.4%)].

How many workers in Peel-Halton (PH) use non-official languages at work?

Compared to Canada, PH had a higher proportions of workers who used non-official languages at work in 2006 [Canada (1.5%) versus PH (1.6%)].
