



#### JOB POSTINGS BY SECTOR BY MONTH FOR PEEL & HALTON







### **JOB POSTINGS BY SKILL TYPE**


What skill type is being recruited?


What education do occupations typically require?






### **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
