







JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR PEEL & HALTON REGIONS










DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)







DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)









Full-time vs Part-time




JOB DURATION












