

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?













# **DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)**

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?























Full-time vs Part-time












### **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
