

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




















# **DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)**









Full-time vs Part-time




#### **JOB DURATION**

Permanency of jobs posted












## **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
