







JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR PEEL & HALTON REGIONS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




AVERAGE POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS

How long are employers having to recruit for to find candidates to fill their job vacancies?










DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)







DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)









Full-time vs Part-time






What broad occupational category is being recruited?










JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
