






JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR PEEL & HALTON REGIONS
















### **DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (PEEL & HALTON REGIONS)**







Full-time vs Part-time






What broad occupational category is being recruited?










### **JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD**
